2. NIZHYN AGROTECHNICAL INSTITUTE: FROM VOCATIONAL SCHOOL TO THE INSTITUTE

Key dates in the history of the formation of Nizhyn Agrotechnical Institute are as follows:

July 1, 1895 – Nizhyn Vocational School was founded

July 1, 1900 – Nizhyn Vocational School was renamed into Nizhyn Technical School named after O.F. Kushakevych

1920 – Nizhyn Polytechnic School was established on the foundation of Nizhyn Technical School

1922 – The Polytechnic School was reorganized into the Technical School of Chemistry and Mechanization, and soon into Agrotechnical School with the agricultural machine-building department

1929 – The Agrotechnical School was reorganized into the Industrial Technical School

1933 – Nizhyn Technical School of Mechanization of Agriculture was founded

1993 – The Technical School of Mechanization was reorganized into Nizhyn Agrotechnical College (Order of Ministry of Agriculture and Food of Ukraine, dated August 4, 1993, №214)

1996 – Nizhyn Agrotechnical College was given under the management of National Agrarian University (Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, dated April 23, 1996, №448)

2001 – Nizhyn Agrotechnical Institute was formed within National Agrarian University (Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, dated May 16, 2001, № 508)

2005 – Agrotechnical Institute was accredited as the Institute with the III Level of Accreditation (Decision of State Certification Committee, dated May 24, 2005, №56)

2006 – Agrotechnical Institute was made a separate subdivision of National Agrarian University “Nizhyn Agrotechnical Institute” (Order of National Agrarian University, dated June 19, 2006, №392)

2008 – A Separate Subdivision of National Agrarian University was renamed into a Separate Subdivision of National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine “Nizhyn Agrotechnical Institute” (Resolution № 945 of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated October 10, 2008 and the Order of National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine dated December 12, 2008).

5. THE ORGANIZATION OF EDUCATIONAL PROCESS IN SS OF NULES OF UKRAINE «NIZHYN AGROTECHNICAL INSTITUTE»

Educational process in SS of NULES of Ukraine «Nizhyn Agrotechnical Institute» is a system of organizational and didactic activities aimed at implementing the curriculum at a certain level of skill or education in accordance with state educational standards and is based on the principles of science, humanism, democracy, continuity, independence of interference from any political parties and other civic and religious organizations. Courses organized considering opportunities of modern information technology focused on training and formation of an educated, harmoniously developed personality capable to continuous updating of



scientific knowledge, professional mobility and rapid adaptation to changes and development in the socio-cultural field, in engineering, technology, management systems and the organization of labor in a market economy.

The educational process is done learning by institute units (faculties, chairs, departments, cycles commissions). The Institute provides students with the opportunity to use the classrooms, library, training, teaching and scientific literature, equipment and other teaching aids under the conditions defined by internal regulations.

Training is carried out in the following forms: training lessons, individual assignments, independent work of students, practical training, control measures. Teaching of students is provided in accordance with the curricula in the credit system.

5.1 European Credit Transfer System

European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) is a system that is designed to provide uniform procedures for interstate measurement and comparison between educational learning outcomes of students, their academic recognition. It is designed to ensure the mobility of students, facilitates understanding and comparison of curriculum and student achievement as between domestic and foreign universities. The system is based on the assessment all types of students needed to achieve the objectives set out in the curriculum. Developed in the 1989/1990 academic year in the form of 5-year pilot project in the international program Erasmus, which was attended by 145 European universities.

Key elements of the system:

- information pack containing information on institutions, departments, organization and structure of the training disciplines, the conditions for independent work, housing, leisure, etc.;
- mutual agreement between the partner institutions and the student in the form of the application form / learning agreement;
- institution and faculties ECTS coordinators engaged under the administrative and academic aspects of ECTS and advise students;
- the transcript of the items that shows students' learning achievements in a way that is comprehensive, commonly understood and easily transferable from one institution to another.

Credits ECTS, which is a numerical value (between 1 and 60) allocated to course units to describe the student workload required to complete them. They reflect the quantity of work each course unit requires relative to the total quantity of work necessary to complete a full year of academic study at the institution, ie lectures, seminars, practical work, tutorials, practical training, independent work (in the library or at home), examinations or other activities associated with the evaluation. In ECTS, 60 credits represent the workload of a student for one academic year and are usually 30 credits per semester. Credits are measured in hours. 1 credit is 30 hours.

5.2 The main types of classes at the institute:

- Lecture;
- Laboratory, practical, seminar, individual training;
- Consultation.



Lecture – is the main form of instruction in higher education, based on theoretical material. Typically, a lecture is part of a lecture course that covers the basic theoretical material particular or several topics of the course. Lectures are held by lecturers - professors and associated professors (teachers) as well as leading scientists and experts invited to give lectures. Lectures are conducted in specially equipped rooms - rooms for one or more academic groups of students.

Laboratory studies – is a form of instruction in which the student under the guidance of a supervisor or conducting full-scale simulation experiments investigate the practical confirmation of certain theoretical assumptions of this study, to obtain practical experience working with complex equipment, computers, instrumentation, experimental methods research in a particular subject area. Laboratory classes are conducted in specially equipped training labs using equipment adapted to the learning process (laboratory models, settings, etc.). In some cases, laboratory studies can be conducted in a real professional environment (eg, at school, at work, in research laboratories).

Practice – is a form of instruction in which the teacher organizes detailed study of certain theoretical principles of academic discipline and skill of their practical application through individual performance of various tasks. Workshops are held in classrooms or educational laboratories equipped with the necessary technical facilities, computer facilities. Practice is held with the students, whose number is less than half of the academic group. Practical lessons based on pre-prepared methodological materials - tests to identify the degree of mastering the necessary theoretical propositions, the set of tasks of varying complexity for solving their students in class.



Seminars – is a form of instruction in which the teacher organizes the discussion around certain topics in which students prepare theses on the basis of individual assignments (essays). Seminars are held in classrooms or classrooms with one academic group. Each teacher estimates prepared by students in different disciplines, their performances, active in debate, ability to articulate and defend their position.

Individual training conducted with individual students to increase their level of preparation and disclosure of personal creativity. Individual training sessions are organized on a separate schedule based on the individual student and the curriculum may cover part or all of sessions with one or more subjects, and in some cases - the full range of classes for specific educational or skill level.

Consultation – is a form of instruction in which the student receives a response from the teacher to specific questions or to explain certain theoretical positions or aspects of their practical the application. Advice can be provided to an individual or group of students, depending on whether the teacher advises students on issues related to the execution of individual tasks or with theoretical issues of the course. Individual tasks on specific disciplines (abstract, design, graphic, of course projects or work, etc.) are issued to students at the time stipulated university. Individual tasks are performed independently with student advising teacher. There may be cases of execution of complex multi-subject students.

Course projects (work) performed in order to consolidate, deepen and synthesis of knowledge obtained by students during training and their application to solving complex specific professional tasks. Topics course projects (works) must meet objective of the course and is closely linked with the practical needs of a particular profession.



Diploma work is done at the final stage of training students in universytetii and include:

- arrangement, consolidation, expansion of theoretical and practical knowledge in the specialty and their use in addressing specific scientific, technical, economic, industrial and other tasks;
- developing skills of independent work and mastery of technique and experimental study related to the topic of the project (work).

Independent work of students is the ultimate mastery of training material at the time free from mandatory training sessions.

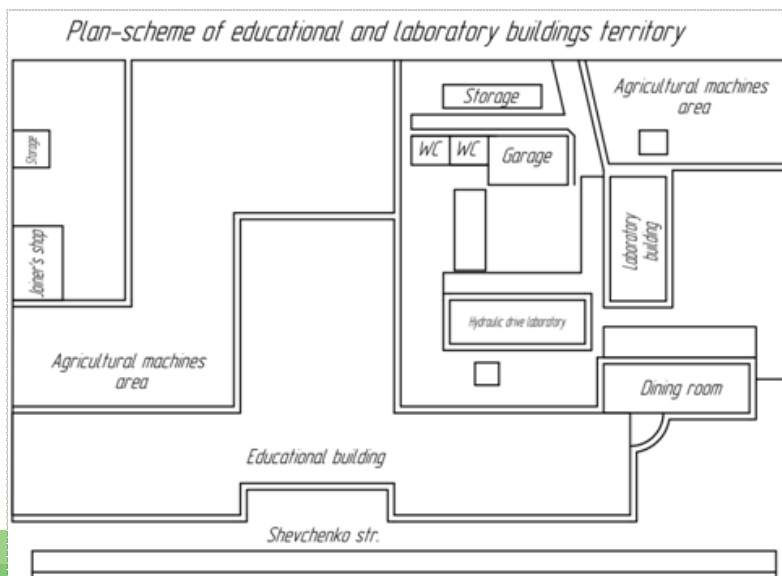

Room of the History of the institute opened in 1980.

The museum presents all the stages of formation and development of the institution, from Vocational School to Technical School of Mechanization of Agriculture (1895-1933 years), from Technical School to Nizhyn Agrotechnical College (1933-1993), from college to Nizhyn



agrotechnical institute of National Agricultural University (1993-2001 City) and current SS of NULES of Ukraine «Nizhyn agrotechnical institute».

Room of military and labor glory opened in 1970. The museum tells the story of our countrymen - participants of the Civil War (1918-1920), World War II (1941-1945), graduates Nizhyn technical school of mechanization of agriculture, who died in the war in Afghanistan (1979-1989 gg.) An important part of the museum is a diorama «Battle for Nizhyn», the author - a member of the Union of Artists of Ukraine Mordovtsev A.M. In peacetime, praised his hard school graduates - Heroes of Socialist Labor. Over the

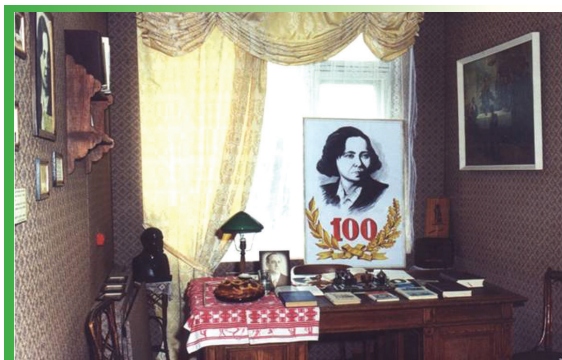

production in Ukraine. The meeting of veterans of war and labor are constantly held at the museum.

who was born and spent her childhood in the walls of vocational school. In the 1970's and 80's group the students historical «Poshuk» maintained correspondence with academician, interested in her life and work. Most personal items and books, which she bequeathed to the museum, the political groundwork for exposure in Nizhyn Agrotechnical Institute.



Ethnographic room «Ukrainian past» was created in 1990. Ukrainian parlor, household items, handicrafts masters of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries - more than 400 exhibits are

presented the room. Ukrainian towels from all parts of Chernihiv region are presented here.

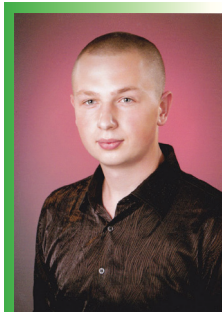
7. SOCIAL ORGANIZATIONS

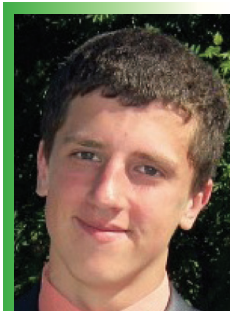
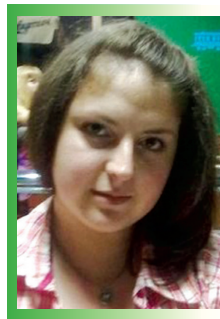

A STUDENT WHO LIVES IN A HOSTEL,
OBLIGED:

- know and follow the rules of hostel internal order;
- timely pay for accommodation and additional paid services, which he enjoys;
 - maintain cleanliness and order in their rooms and common areas, to participate in all kinds of work related to self;
 - care of the property of hostel economical use of heat, electricity, gas and water;
 - ensure that a duplicate key to the room in the hostel manager, and in case of replacement of the lock in the door - pass it the appropriate duplicate keys;
 - timely apply for the repair of electrical, plumbing equipment and furniture;
 - all incidents in the hostel immediately notify the head of the hostel and student government hostel;
 - reimburse caused material damage in accordance with the law;
 - adhere to safety regulations and fire safety;
 - record additional appliances in the dorm head;
 - prevent the hostel manager (commander) for leaving the hostel for a long time (more than 5 days);
 - after graduation or upon early deprivation of the right to hand over the accommodation hostel property that was in its use, and the room in good condition and move out of the hostel in two weeks.



A STUDENT WHO LIVES IN THE HOSTEL FOR, BIDDEN:

- move from one room to another without the consent of the head of the hostel;
- remodel or move equipment and furniture from one room to another or make them from the hostel without the permission of the head of the hostel;
- carry out electrical work in the rooms and dormitory, recycle and repair electrical equipment;
- use electric heaters and electric stoves in the living rooms;
- mass actions in the hostel without the written permission of the commandant of the hostel;
- keep outsiders after 23.00 without the written permission of the commandant of the hostel;
- smoke, drink and store alcohol, narcotic or toxic substances, stay in a hostel in a state of alcoholic, narcotic or toxic intoxication;
- break the silence from 22-00 to 07-00;
- create a buzz and turn the television, computer and audio equipment for the high volume;
- keep animals in a hostel.

9. SOCIAL PROTECTION OF STUDENTS AND HEALTHCARE

Social protection of students and staff is done by the Trade union committee of the Institute, who cares about a favorable socio-psychological climate at the Institute. All rights of workers and students safety protected, created appropriate conditions for research, training and educational work.

Health care of students and workers exercised at the Institute by Health Services, which is equipped with procedure room and 3 insulators. Nizhyn Agrotechnical Institute has rich experience in international cooperation. The Institute was visited by representatives from more than 50 countries since the foundation of international friendship club.

An agreement on cooperation between the Institute and the Industrial and Economic College named after academic H.S.Seytkasymova (Republic of Kazakhstan) was signed in 2012

12. LIBRARY OF THE INSTITUTE

Library, which provides education at the institute consists of two departments - subscription and 2 reading halls for 115 seats.

The library has more than 90,000 copies. Every year the Institute subscribes over 75 periodicals. It offers readers include printed periodicals: magazines «Journal of Agricultural Sciences», «Ukraine's economy», «Economics agriculture», «Agricultural engineering», «Offer», etc.; Newspaper «Voice of Ukraine», «Youth of Ukraine», «Desnyanska truth» and so on.

Much attention is paid to Suppliers. Regularly purchased books for students in the fields.

Great importance is attached to the mass of work: annually organizes over 30 thematic book fairs, open views of literature, held reading conferences, literary events, debates.

One of the most valuable achievements of the library - a set of Rare Books. The library is a valuable edition of 128 copies. Real jewel of the fund is «Collegiate Dictionary» Brockhaus (1890), «History of Mathematics» (1883), «Encyclopedia of Agriculture» (1900), «Collection of works be Goethe» (1878).

Library tries to keep up with scientific and technological progress, introduces innovative forms library processes work. Widespread and comprehensive use of the library fund contributes bibliographic apparatus, information and bibliographic work. In its activities, in addition to traditional forms and techniques the library uses computer technology, implemented the program «Irbis» – library automation system that meets all international standards. The formation of databases, storage of the electronic information

is done with the usage of computers. The volume of electronic catalog now stands at over 30 thousand titles.

Currently, the main goal of the library - the maximum and operational needs associated information needs of teaching and research activities in all areas of professional direction Institute.

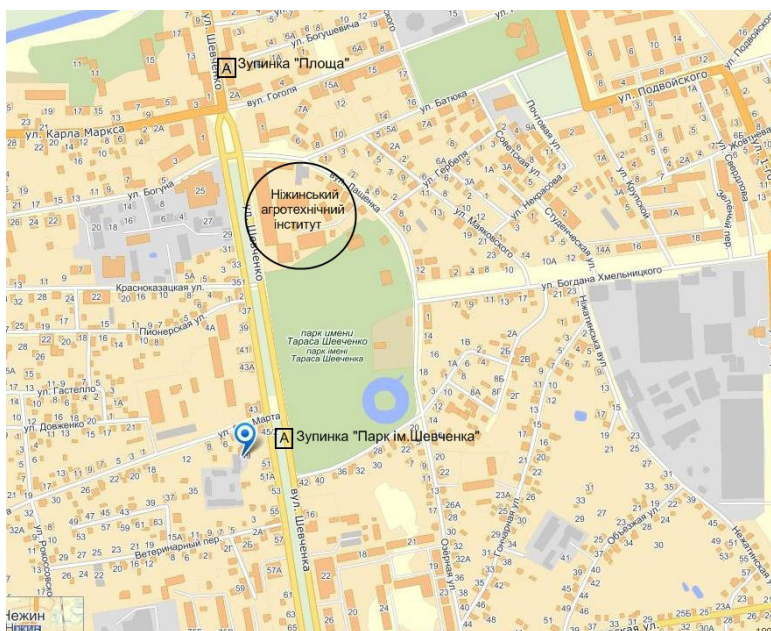
